On 22 March, we announced the cancellation of the May 2020 Diploma Programme and the Career-related Programme examinations and that a decision regarding the May 2020 Middle Years Programme eAssessment examinations will follow.

Our senior team has spent many hours discussing the best option for our students and educators, with their health and safety as a key consideration.

The IB will be taking the following actions for the 2020 May MYP eAssessment session:

- May 2020 MYP on-screen examinations are cancelled.
- ePortfolio and Personal Projects grades will be issued.
- MYP certificate will be awarded, reflecting achievements from a combination of Personal Project, ePortfolio subjects, and predicted grades for other subjects.
